V1300X-DVC/RVC Keypad Alarm Handling

- 1. Situation: When using a V1300X-DVC/RVC Intelligent Remote Control Panel (keypad) in the Standalone mode, there is a conflict in alarm handling when processing an alarm from a *Surveyor*® dome camera. The dome does not attain the selected Preset Position. This is evident in Keypads with software versions of 3.1 or earlier.
- 2. Symptom: Regardless of the alarm programming within the *Surveyor*, the keypad will always send a PP1 (preset position 1) command to the dome on receipt of an alarm indication from the dome.
- **3. Explanation:** The keypad software is programmed to send PP1 as the response to any alarm indication.

4. Solution:

- Set the *Alarm Report* feature in the Surveyor programming to *Disable* to prevent the keypad from receiving the alarm. Doing so will require selecting *Momentary* alarms and also setting the Surveyor *Auto Acknowledge* feature to On.
- Upgrade the keypad to software version 3.2 (Vicon Part Number 1251-3465-00-00) or later.
